
Innovation from the Top Down: A Bold, Custom Roof for Austin Hose Headquarters

Challenges

From the outset, the project required out-of-the-box thinking to balance functionality, cost-efficiency, and aesthetics. The key challenges included:

- Metal Deck Design Constraints The metal deck provided in the building package had flutes too wide for standard polyiso insulation, making traditional installation methods unfeasible.
- Surface Temperature Variations The combination of gray and yellow TPO membranes created temperature differentials during installation, requiring extra precision in welding to ensure proper seam adhesion.
- Custom Branding Integration Austin Hose wanted a roof that visually reflected their brand, requiring a custom shade of yellow not readily available from most manufacturers.

With these challenges in mind, the project team needed an innovative solution to achieve the company's design and performance goals.

Solution:

To address the metal deck issue, Playa Design Studio and Tecta America Amarillo CS devised a creative approach—flipping the U-panel roof deck upside down.

"We challenged the norms by turning the U-panel roof deck upside down, which worked perfectly to remain cost-effective by eliminating the need for flute fill insulation," said Tyler Rathburn, Project Manager, Tecta America Amarillo CS.

Building on this innovative foundation, Tecta America Amarillo CS:

- Used GAF's Induction-Weld System to fasten directly into the purlins, ensuring quick installation and strong uplift resistance
- Navigated weather-related challenges with a flexible, non-adhesive approach
- Collaborated with GAF Design Services to custom-match the Goldenrod yellow from Austin Hose's logo, creating a seamless brand integration

"It was difficult to find a manufacturer capable of providing us with the custom shade of yellow that we needed, until we worked with GAF Design Services," said Mason Rogers, Architect/Owner, Playa Design Studio.

The final design featured long horizontal stripes that subtly referenced the hose industry, reinforcing Austin Hose's identity through both functionality and aesthetics.
